Last summer, over 80 BC FSL educators went to Vichy, France to perfect their French while learning about the Common European Framework for Languages. They also undertook training on the DELF (*Diplômes d'études en langue française*). This summer however, BC French educators will have the opportunity to undergo training on the DELF in Richmond, BC at the Radisson Hotel from August 25-29<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

The registration date has been extended to **June 30<sup>th</sup>** at a registration cost of \$200. This will be an opportunity to get training to be DELF examinateurs/correcteurs.
