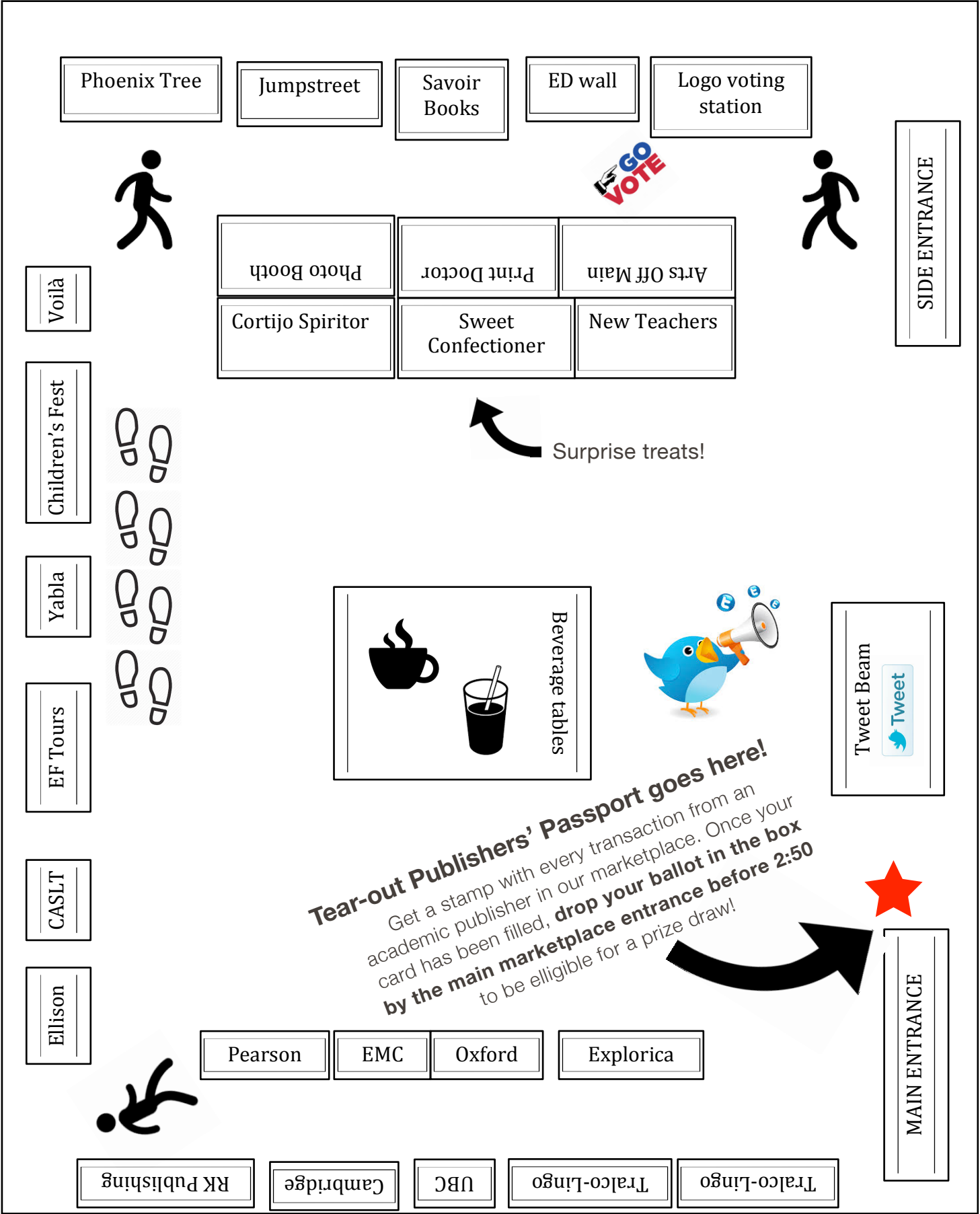

Conference Map



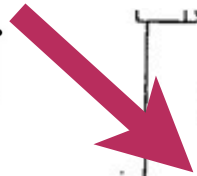
